Available across three ranges, Gali (water/rhythm), Yuundu (rock/fossil) and Thulu (forest/bark), in convenient 500mm x 500mm carpet tiles that are easy to maintain and heavily stocked in Australia for fast delivery.

Produced by German supplier ANKER using energy-efficient processes, the collection is manufactured using Aquafil eco-friendly solution dyed fibre with a sustainable PE backing containing optimally matched layers of latex, bitumen and PVC-free components, delivering exceptional laying and lying properties with genuine cultural significance.



Issues such as sustainability, ecology, recycling, and environmental friendliness are key pillars of our German supplier ANKER's corporate strategy.
